There needs to be more support for people getting on and off the bus

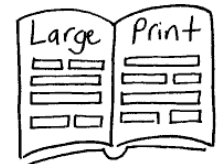
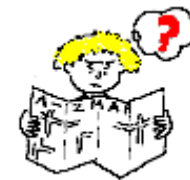


Accessibility
